Fairfield Beach & Town Marina Information

- Beaches:** Five saltwater beaches in Fairfield with full time lifeguards. Rest rooms with indoor/outdoor shower facilities & some with food concession with free library. Some beaches are supplied with outdoor grills & picnic tables.

- Free concerts:** Penfield pavilion
- Annual July 4TH Fireworks:** Display outside Jennings Beach area can be seen along Fairfield's shoreline.

- Lake Mohegan:** 200 acre Town Park & fresh fed water lake used for swimming and fishing. Rest rooms with indoor/outdoor shower facilities & food concession with free library & lifeguards. Outdoor grills/picnic tables & playground
- Marina:**
South Benson Marina: Located along the southeastern portion of Fairfield's shoreline is one of the most well protected marinas around. This town run marina has a total of 650 boats ranging from 14 feet to 36 feet long with beam sizes up to 13 feet wide. There are floating docks A through I with water, and docks H and I with 30 amp. Dockside power for each individual vessel. Electricity at the entry way to each dock. Optional cable & telephone lines to each boat. (Paid by individual boat owner) There are two launch ramps for those who trailer their boats. Excellent security with guard station. Fairfield Marina Police building with two rest rooms. Two town owned marine patrol boats. A gas dock with food and bait concession. The Moore fishing pier is a total enjoyment for those who love fishing. The marina is open from April 15 through the third Sunday of November. Transient docks are also available during the season. Winter water storage is also available in the marina with bubbler systems and electricity. (Paid by individual boat owner)
